These are some of the most commonly used words that appear on the test:

1. **inclusion** **inclusive** **include** **including**
(basic meaning: have something in or added to something else)

In an attempt to include everyone, management has created an all-inclusive weekend training trip, including airfare, accommodations and meals. The inclusion of airfare makes the trip affordable for our lower-salaried staff.

2. **remarkably** **remark** **remarkable** **remarking**
(say one's opinion // unusual or surprising, so people notice)

My friend made a remark today about the growing number of homeless people. It is remarkable how, that in just a few years, it has so remarkably increased. We were remarking that the government has done almost nothing to address this issue.

3. **indicate** **indicative** **indicatively** **indication**
(show that something is true or exists, or is possible)

The numbers clearly indicate that the company is losing a lot of money! This is indicative of poor management. There's no clear indication yet that management will be fired, but the board is indicatively hinting at it.

4. **delight** **to delight** **delightful** **delightfully**
(give someone great joy/happiness/pleasure)

It was delightful to see that famous artist performing again after so many years. She delightfully danced and sang many of her old hits to the delight of her fans. She hopes to delight many more as she begins her 1st world tour in 10 years.

5. **familiar** **familiarly** **familiarize** **familiarity**
(to know about something or try to get to know about something)

At first, Ann was not really familiar with NY. So she walked the streets to familiarize herself with it. Now her familiarity with the city is amazing! Surprisingly, she found a place that is familiarly similar to places in her hometown.
