

For the first time in/since...(1)

This is used when you want to say that you haven't done something in some period of time.

For the first time in... refers to *how long it has been*

I played tennis today. The last time was *10 years ago*.

I played tennis for the first time in 10 years.

For the first time since... refers to *the last time/event you did it*

I played tennis today. The last time was in high school.

I played tennis for the first time since high school.
