## Is it a VERB or an ADJECTIVE? (1)

Sometimes the past tense verb form and the adjective have the same spelling. This sheet will help you decide which one it is

**<u>Verb</u>**  $\rightarrow$  When it is the verb, it's often the first verb of the sentence:

Work really **tired** me out today.

Amy <b>cooked</b> a turkey for Christmas dinner.
<ul> <li>Adjective → When it is the adjective, it often has a form of be (am, is, was, were) before it or is connected to the noun after it:</li> <li>I was really tired after work today.</li> <li>Amy bought a cooked turkey for Christmas dinner.</li> <li>The cooked turkey Amy bought was delicious.</li> </ul>
