Generally, there are 2 way to use **end up verb-ing**

1. *When your original plan can't be done; you do "Plan B"*

My car wouldn't start, so I **ended up walking** to the store.
(original plan) (Plan B)

2. *When you had not previously decided something, but then later made a decision*

You said you wanted to see a movie this weekend. What did you **end up seeing?**
